JOB SEARCH ASSISTANCE AND CAREER GUIDANCE

Individual assistance to help you identify your skills and interests and match you to occupations.

Information on and referral to training and education programs.

FEDERAL BONDING PROGRAM

Assistance program for individuals who are unable to obtain commercial bonding required by employers.
